## Overview

In this second part of our study of how the wisdom of God is understood and received by the work of the Holy Spirit, Paul describes how understanding God is not something achieved by human reason. Instead, it is an act of grace where God's Spirit illuminates the truth of the gospel to us. Those who do not have the Spirit, who rely solely on their own wisdom, will never understand the deep things of God. As we receive the truth of God, about the Word of God, through the Spirit of God—we are then commissioned to speak this truth to others in the power of the Holy Spirit.
