

Luke 7:11-17 Message-based Small Group Lesson

Opening

- 1. Allow sixty seconds for the group to list all the expressions they can think of that include the words "dead", "death", "dying" or "die" in them.
- 2. What circumstances usually cause us to think about death?
- 3. Have you thought about death lately or do you try to avoid thinking about it? Explain.
- 4. Why do you think death is so emotionally painful for us?

Interaction with the text

1. As you read Luke 7:11-17, what was the impact of this man's death on his mother? On the community?

- 2. How does the reality of death shape the way we think about life?
- 3. Another great demonstration of Jesus lordship over death is found in the story of Lazarus. Read John 11:1-44.
- 4. How does Jesus use this event as a teaching opportunity about himself (see John 11:25)?

Application to life

- 1. Do you know that you have victory over death? If so, how?
- 2. How can knowing that Jesus has the power to raise you up from the dead help you live your life now?
- 3. Do you think that knowing that Jesus has victory over death could make you look at those around you differently? Explain.
