Overview

Continuing in our "We Believe" series, this Sunday's message focuses on our belief in God the Holy Spirit. Often, when we think of the Holy Spirit, we may think of a force or energy. The Holy Spirit, in actuality, is a person. He is promised, has a purpose, and the power to work in our lives.

Engaging with each other

1. In his message, Danny Hall referred to Francis Chan's book about the Holy Spirit, *The Forgotten God*. Why do you think Chan chose that title? What do you like or dislike about the title?

2. In His final address to His disciples (John 14-16), Jesus speaks about the Holy Spirit a number of times. Why is it crucial that Jesus is directing the disciples to the Holy Spirit at this time?
