Cambodia ministries

I will be in Cambodia at the end of March to conduct three training classes in two provinces. Those classes will be in Siem Reap and in Battambang Province. Please **pray** for travel mercy and that God would work through those who hear the needs in Cambodia and partner with us to reach Cambodia for Christ.

I want to take this opportunity to thank some partners, friends, family and churches that sent in their generous gifts to make this trip possible for me. Please **pray** for me as I need wisdom to perform my duty as mentor to our beloved pastors and leaders there. I **pray** that through you God will provide needed funds for me to go and serve Him in Cambodia.

Cambodia flood victims that lost their home still need help. They need household items and food. We are trying to raise \$10,000 to help some of the flood victims affected by this tragedy, but since my last two appeals I only received one donation. Please help us to reach out to them with the love of Christ.

The CMC Center is serving to glorify God among the unbeliever in a few villages in that area. Since January we have a few teams of intern come to help teach English and other programs. We also sent those teams to help a couple of orphanages in Siem Reap City. We still have seven classes to help children who can't afford to go to regular school plus two computer classes. We are giving scholarships to a couple students to attend college and provided a place for students to stay so that they would be near the school. We also have children sponsorship to help those poor children and orphans.

Our leadership training still continue in Cambodia through the Center connection. The training is in Siem Reap and Battambang. we have other trainers want to come to help please pray for them. Please **pray** that God will continue to provide needed funding to run all the ministry in

Cambodia, we need \$1,000 per month to operate.

We thank the Lord for giving us a center to do ministry among the poor and reach out to the nonbelievers. We still need \$25,000 to finish the worship area, we also need to bring a higher power line into the center and need to install rainstorm draining system. Would you please **pray** with us for God's provision for these needs? We are thankful to many of you who continue to support the Lord's ministry through us and give us a chance to serve Him among Cambodian people at the "Training Center" and throughout Cambodia. We're still looking for those of you who are able to partner with us to construct church buildings in Cambodia. There are many requests for church building that we can't fulfill. We also need medical teams to come and help treat the poor in Cambodia. Please **pray** for more partners to come and help with medical program. If you would like to help, please contact us.

CMC continues to provide programs such as water wells to help the local community with clean water. This year we thank the Lord for providing 43 wells through two Churches. Most of the rural areas that we work with have no water in their summer time. There are many other things that we do among the poor of Cambodia but we can't do it alone and we need you as our partner. Won't you pray and consider becoming our partner to reach Cambodia for Christ?
